


OCEAN met with representatives of DG SANTE on 16.11.2016 to know the latest state of play for what regards the Official Controls proposals:


- Where are we?

#### **TIME FRAME**










Regarding official controls at borders (Article 47) and Decisions on consignments (Article 53):

The compromise would propose that:



- the physical checks would have to be done by the OV, who may be assisted by trained staff, for animals (except aquatic), meat and edible offal. For the other food, the physical checks would be performed by the OV or staff trained.
- The decision on each consignments, after the checks, will have to be taken by:
  - ✓ the OV for animals, meat and products of animal origin;



✓ the appropriate staff trained for fishery products, live bivalve molluscs, live echinoderms, live tunicates and live marine gastropods intended for human consumption.



the <u>frequency of physical and identity checks will be performed on a risk</u> <u>basis (Article 52)</u> for all products, goods.

# **NO CHANGES**



**Article 47 (official controls at borders)**: delegated acts (and not anymore implementing acts) will be adopted concerning specific training requirements for staff for the performance of the physical checks at the border control posts.

According to **Article 49 and Article 75** of the compromise text (official controls on transhipped consignments and transit of consignments of the goods) **the Commission shall adopt delegated acts** to establish:

✓ the cases where and

✓ the <u>conditions</u> under which

derogations to the rules on documentary, identity and physical checks apply to those.

The model/format of official certificates and rules for the issuance of such certificates will be decided in implementing acts lay down by the Commission.

## **NO CHANGES**



Main points of the meeting with the Commission services:

- 40 implementing and delegated acts need to be drafted only for what regards "Imports"
- The Commission will organise meetings with the stakeholders for consultations
- New procedure for providing comments to implementing and delegated acts (publicly available for 4 weeks!) -> <u>better to take contacts before this procedure starts!!!</u>
- A specific chapter is foreseen for what regards IT Systems. National authorities should be involved!
- On 19<sup>th</sup> November 2016, the Juristic and linguistic check in the Council should be over and a final version of the proposal should be available.
